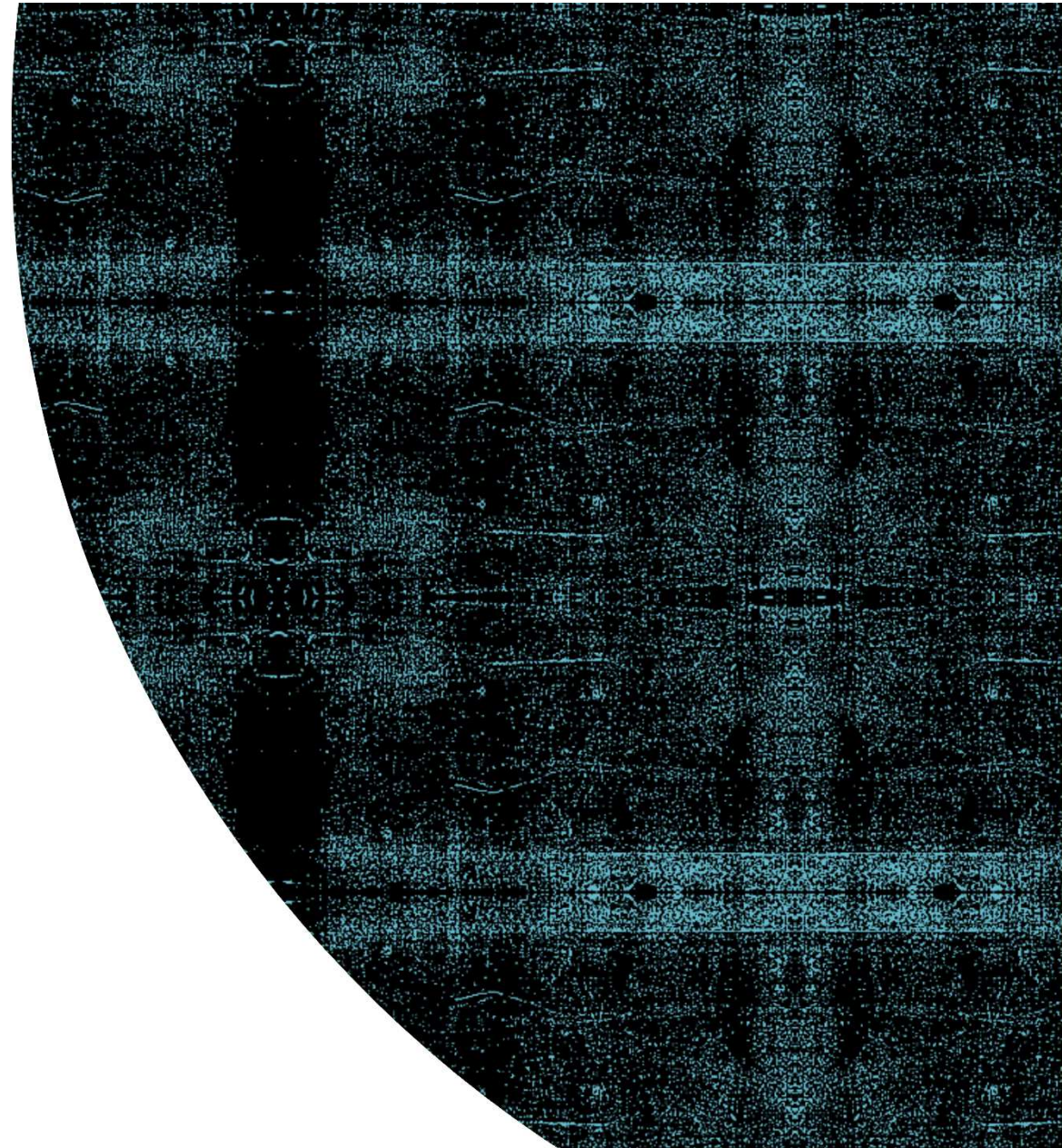

- Encouraging recycling in communities.

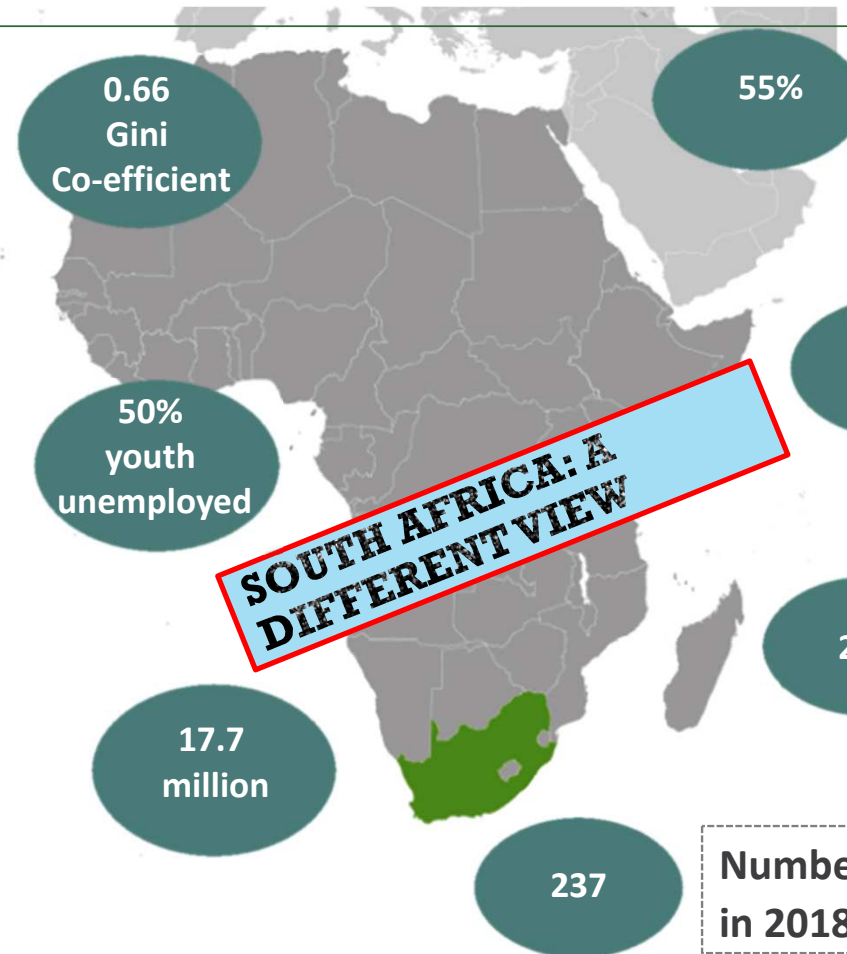


Context

FOCUS ON PLASTIC WASTE

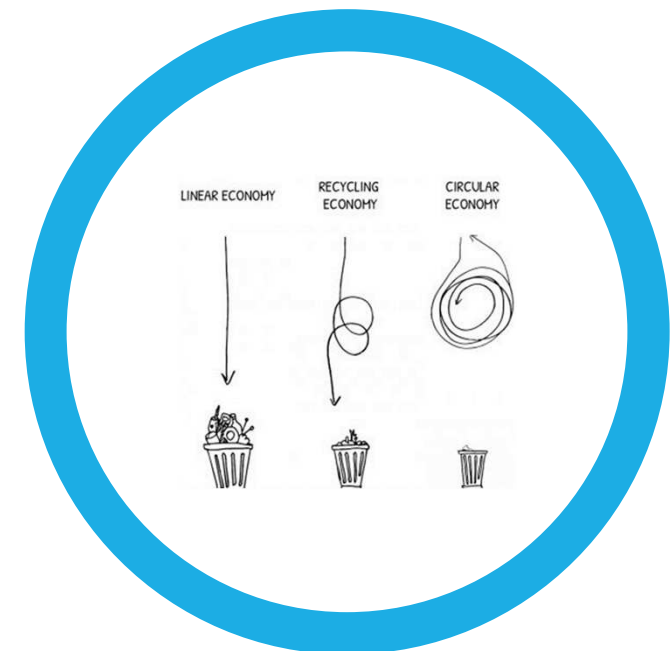
Environment shows signs of our throw-away attitude to plastics and other packaging materials

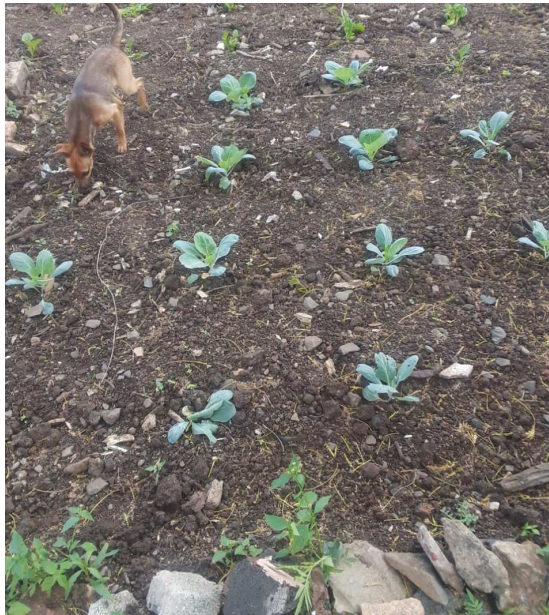
Outcry to reduce marine and environmental litter

- Assisting communities in informal settlements



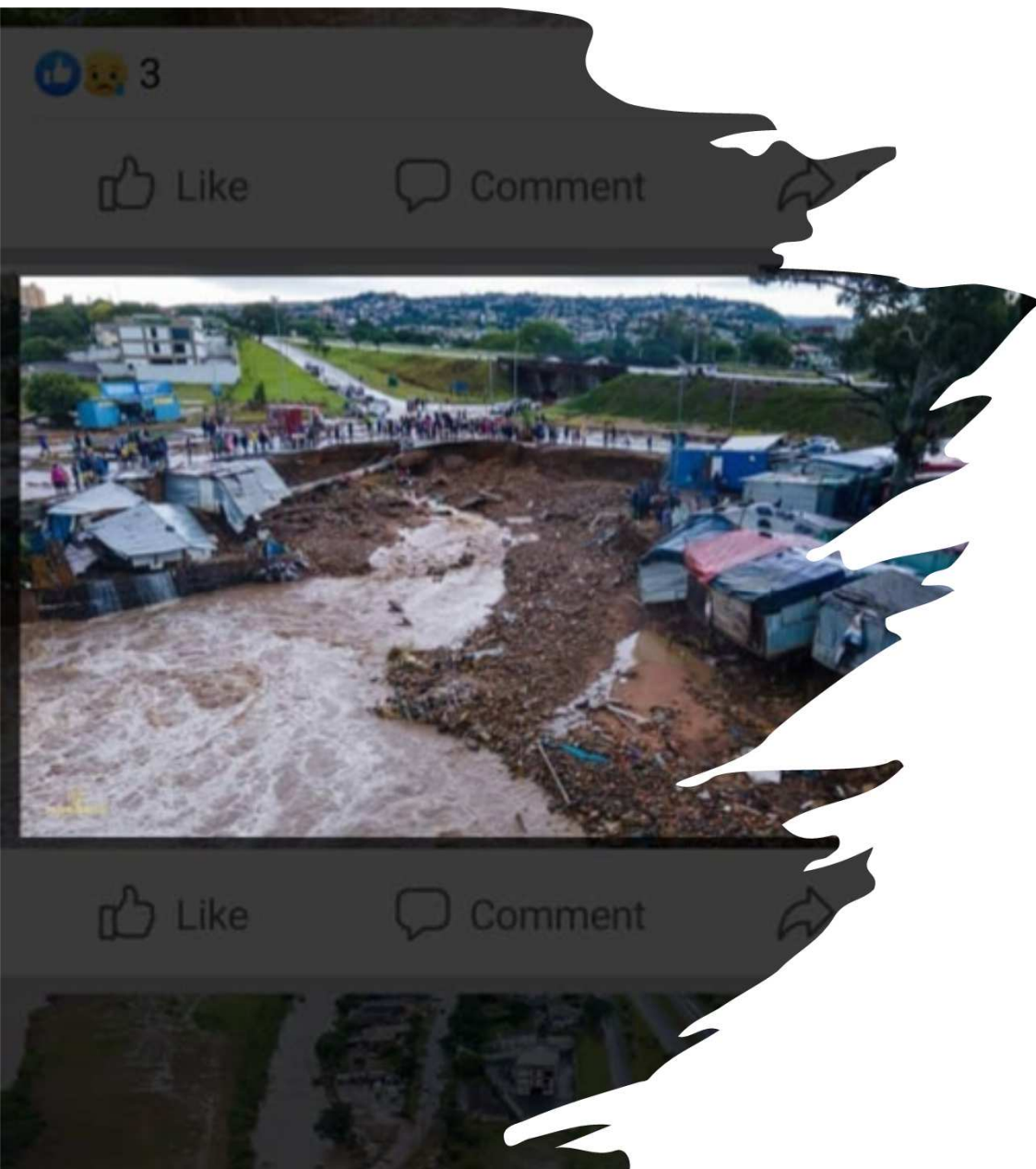
